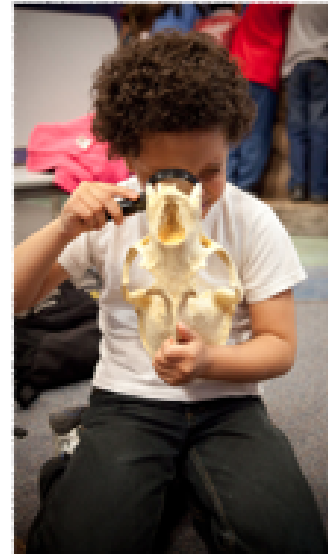
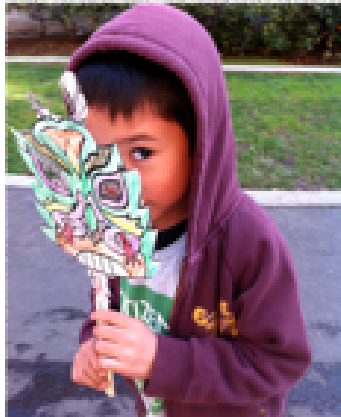

### QUICK REMINDERS ABOUT THE START OF SCHOOL:

- \* **The FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL is Wednesday, September 7th and will run from 8:30 – 1:30.**
- \* **The first three days of school will be early dismissal (Wednesday, Thursday and Friday) with school ending at 1:30 all three days.**
- \* **See the Gentle Beginnings groups and rotation below to see which color group your child(s) is in and how they will rotate to different classrooms in the first three days.**
- \* **We are asking that all families walk their children in during, at least, the first three days. This is especially true for Kindergarteners.**
- \* **School will always begin at 8:30 AM, with drop-off to classrooms starting at 8:15.**
- \* **On Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, we will begin our regular weekly schedule where school days on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays run from 8:30 to 3:15**
- \* **All Wednesdays are early-release days with school running from 8:30 – 1:30.**
- \* **ASP and Morning Care will begin on Sept. 12<sup>th</sup> too!**
- \* **All students should bring a snack each day.**
- \* **Lunch forms for September are due before or on the first day of school.**
- \* **Please bring in requested school supplies in AFTER the first three days of school. Thank you!**

CWC After School Program**

The Citizens of the World After School Program will be offered to students Mondays through Fridays from 3:15-6:00pm. Beginning on September 12<sup>th</sup>.

**\*ALL FAMILIES MUST SUBMIT A FORM EVERY MONTH! Payment is due in advance and will be considered late after the 12th of this month. Forms that are returned after the 12th are considered late and are assessed a \$15 late fee. Late pick-up (anytime after 6pm) will be subject to late fees of \$1.00 per extra minute.** If a parent is more than 10 minutes late to pick up their child on two or more occasions, the child will no longer be able to participate in the after school program.

**This form and payment must be returned by Friday September 9th. For safety purposes students will not be allowed to participate in ASP if a form is not returned by September 12th.**

**No phone calls or notes requesting ASP will be accepted.**

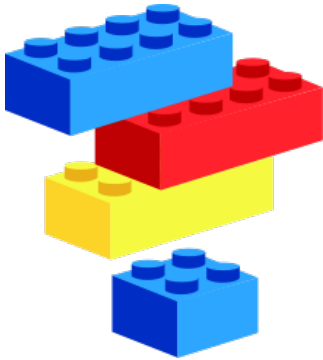

### **Hot Lunch Instructions**

Lunch forms will be distributed through homework folders at the end of each month.

#### **To order lunch:**

- Review that month's lunch form with your child and circle your selections. When a meat dish is offered, there will also be a vegetarian option. In that case, please circle your preference.
- If you do not wish to order a meal for a specific day, leave it unmarked on the order form calendar for that month.
- If your child has allergies please indicate any food allergies on the form.
- Lunches cost \$4.00 per meal. For families who qualify for reduced priced lunch, the cost is \$.40. For families who qualify for free lunch, each day's meal is provided at no cost to you.

#### **Payment:**

- By the deadline, please return your completed lunch order form along with payment (cash or check payable to CWC) to the CWC office or through your child's personal homework folder.
- Regardless of how you turn your form in, it is important to return the form by the due date because it ensures your child will receive a hot meal.
- Thank you for keeping your lunch payments current so as to not accrue a balance.

#### **What if my child forgets to bring lunch to school on a particular day?**

- CWC staff makes every effort to ensure each child has a daily lunch. If a child forgets to bring a lunch to school, we will do our best to provide a meal for your child through an emergency meal supply. You will be charged for the meal, and a notice will be sent home that you owe for the additional lunch meal.
